



Additional Prerequisites to Configure Appzillon

NodeJS

- Version 12 and above.
- Node JS is used to support multiple features in Appzillon like minification, static code analysis, Sass compiling, etc.
- Follow the path to configure Nodejs in Environments.

For example, /usr/local/bin

Uglify-js

- Version 3.15 and above
- Uglify-js is used for the minification of JS files during build in release mode.
- You must install globally using the command `npm install -g uglify-js`.
- Use Sudo to install depending on your system permission configuration
- Follow the path to configure the uglify-js home in environments.

For example, /usr/local/bin

SASS

- Version 1.49 and above
- SASS is used in converting SASS to CSS to change the Appzillon themes.
- You must install the command "`npm install -g sass`" use sudo to install depending on your system permission configuration globally.
- Follow the path to configure the SASS environment.
